# New Yatt Riding for the Disabled Group

The New Yatt Riding for the Disabled Group was set up in 1984 and in 2019 we are celebrating 35<sup>th</sup> years of therapeutic horse riding in West Oxfordshire. From starting out in a field with one pony, we now operate from a purpose-built 21 acre site in North Leigh. We are run by volunteer RDA Coaches and Helpers and currently have 7 working horses and ponies.



Approximately 100 local riders participate annually. Our riders may have a physical disability, learning difficulties or emotional problems. Some may have more than one special need. Each session will comprise 2 or 3 small groups of riders of similar age or riding ability.

Riding is widely recognised as an excellent form of therapy - building self-confidence, helping concentration, co-ordination and balance, providing recreation and sport. Best of all, riding is FUN

## **JOIN US TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE TO OUR LOCAL RIDERS**

We are recruiting new volunteers to join the coaching sessions and to also to help manage the site and ponies on “non session days when no riders attend. During sessions our helpers groom and tack up our horses and ponies; assist the qualified Coaches with mounting and dismounting riders and support the riders by leading or side-walking.
