New Yatt RDA "200 Club" Rules

1. The object of the Club is to raise funds for New Yatt Riding for the Disabled (NYRDA).
2. The Club will be run under the supervision of the NYRDA Trustees who have registered with West Oxfordshire District Council (Small Society Lottery Registration No:977)
3. The club is open to all helpers, riders and supporters of NYRDA, their family and friends and residents of the surrounding area.
4. Members must be aged 16 or over.
5. Members must fill in an application form. Additional forms are available to collect from the Tack Room or from Sally Allum-Smith sallyrda200@outlook.com
6. Membership will be by subscription of £12 per year for each ticket, paid in advance.
7. Members may purchase more than one ticket.
8. The monthly prize fund will be 50% of the monthly income less expenses and will be announced before the first draw.
9. The 12 random draws will be made on the 3rd Saturday of each month
10. Winners will be contacted personally and their names will be posted on NYRDA Tack Room notice board and on the NYRDA website each month after the draw
11. A register will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
12. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into NYRDA funds after 3 months.
13. Tickets are non transferable and non refundable

The New Yatt Riding for the Disabled Group was set up in 1984. We now operate from a purpose-built site in North Leigh, West Oxfordshire comprising stable block and stalls, barn and Indoor Arena, which was built in 2005 to ensure year round riding.

New Yatt RDA is an independent incorporated charity, on 17th February 2015 all funds/assets were transferred from New Yatt Riding for the Disabled Association (1073635)

Our objectives are to provide horse riding activities for disabled people in the Oxfordshire area and to raise funds in support of those activities.

NYRDA is run solely by volunteers and, with 8 working horses and ponies, provides riding instruction to approximately 100 children, teenagers and adults each year.

NYRDA is affiliated to the UK wide **Riding for the Disabled Association incorporating Carriage Driving** which has pioneered disabled riding activities since 1965. The Association now has over 500 member Groups in Great Britain and Northern Ireland, catering for more than 24,000 riders and carriage drivers. www.rda.org.uk
